Visa Requirement	After the boarder has been opened, students may apply for their Chinese student Visa （X Visa） at the Chinese Embassy or Consulate in the home country. Exchange students who will be studying for more than 6 months are required to obtain an X1 Visa, while students who will be studying for less than 6 months are required to obtain an X2 visa.
Accommodation	Exchange students are guaranteed on-campus dormitory at their own expense and payment is made upon arrival. Fee: Single room: 800 RMB /month Twin room: 400 RMB/person/month

Course for Exchange students	Incoming exchange students are free to choose courses regardless of their study fields after consultation with academic advisers at home university. All subjects in CQUPT are open to exchange students, including Chinese Language course, undergraduate courses and graduate courses. The subjects could be found in the attachment.

Tuition Fee	Tuition fees are waived during the exchange period
